Globally, fossil fuel dependent transport sector accounts for around 25% of CO₂ emissions

Cement production is responsible for around 7% of worldwide greenhouse gas emissions

Use cement judiciously. Dispose Construction & demolition waste in authorised waste management centres.









To raise 1 kg of Rice we require 2800 L of water but to raise Millets we require only 900 L of water

Millets are Climate, Environment, Water and Health friendly.
Include millets based meal daily









Aerators can reduce your water consumption in the Kitchen and Bathroom by 50%.

Fix Tap aerators today and conserve water for tomorrow









Recycling 1 ton of paper saves 26,500 litres of water and 17 trees.

Use both sides of paper and recycle it after usage









If 10% of mobile phones in Tamil Nadu are overcharged for 2 hours, it may pull out 32310 kWh of electricity

Surface cleaning products can expose us to a similar amount of particles as a busy urban road used by 28,000 vehicles a day

Avoid using scented surface cleaning products









Annually India consumes about 8 million tons of plastic for single use package.

Carbon footprint of a bicycle is only 21 g of CO₂ per kilometer which is less than 1/10 of a car

Use bicycle and be environmental friendly and healthy









Indoor plants can remove up to 87 per cent of air toxins in 24 hours

Growing indoor plants make our living space pleasant and healthy









Carbon footprint of liquid soap is about 25 percent larger than that of bar soaps on per wash basis.

Avoid liquid soap and use eco friendly bar soaps.









Every year more than 375 million single use cartridges are disposed off, contributing to hazardous waste in landfills.

Choose digital communication and make printing a thing of past









In US 3 billion toys are sold each year and 80 percent of all toys end up in landfills and oceans.

India can reduce carbon footprint by as much as 63934+ tons per annum, if one in four journeys is shared ride.

Adopt Carpooling and avoid global warming.









Meat production is responsible for 14.5 % of total global greenhouse gas emissions.

1.5 million swabs are disposed every day, thus impacting the planet in undesirable ways.

Swap cotton bud swab with silicone-tipped swab.

By replacing old single flush toilet with modern dual flush toilet each household can save upto 70 liters per day i.e.25,500 liters per year.

Use modern Dual flush toilets to conserve water.









2.8 million tons of single use wraps are used and thrown away each year globally.

Use Beeswax wrap to avoid Plastic cling

Using 100 L smaller capacity fridge saves about 600 KWh electricity every year.

Use smaller refrigerators and save environment









There is a potential to recover and use about 4.5 million MT of used cooking oil for production of bio-diesel if properly handled

Dispose the used cooking oil to recyclers to save environment

The ice buildup in the appliance doesn't only take up space, but every 2mm of buildup increases the energy consumption by about 10%.

Save energy and environment by regularly defrosting your freezer









Turning your computer off at night reduces energy consumption by about 1KWh per week and cut down CO₂ emission by 63 kg a year.

Turn off your computers when not in use to save your computer and our environment.









A typical household can save about 13,000 liters of water a year by running full laundry loads instead of half loads.

Run your washing machine with full load of laundry to save water and energy.









About 2.7 billion dry cell batteries are consumed annually in India, of which 2.4 billion goes to landfills every year.

Use and dispose your batteries responsibly.









Disposable razors contribute to more than two million tons of plastic waste every year.

Avoid disposal razors and use reusable metal razors









Cleaning your car using wet clothes will reduce water consumption by 75%

Don't wash your cars with water, use wet cloth to save water









Spent chewing gum pieces add up to 561 million kg of plastic waste every year.

Avoid chewing gum, to reduce plastic waste









Cooking with the lid off takes twice the time to heat a pan of water to boiling point, than with the lid on.

Cook with pans covered to save energy and time.









Using a train instead of a domestic flight would reduce your carbon footprint by 70%.

Limit air travel; Limit global warming.









43% of all plastics produced in India are used for packaging, majority being single-use plastic.

Purchase in bulk to save money, and the environment.









A 5kW rooftop solar system saves around 500 units of electricity monthly, thus reducing CO2 emission by 5.475 Tons per year

Install solar panels at your home to save money and environment.









Standby power accounts for 5%-10% of residential energy use and unplugging electric devices could reduce CO2 emission up to 700 Kg per household per annum.

Unplug your electric appliances to save energy and environment.

Average household leaks in India, waste nearly 3.4 trillion litres of water annually while almost 600 million of India's population is water-deprived.

Replace leaking pipe fittings and fixtures as soon as possible to save water.









The annual rainfall in India is 400-million-hectare meters and it uses only 10-20% of it, and the remaining goes waste in the form of surface run-off.

Harvest Rainwater else run out of potable water.









Studies indicate that over 60% of children in India may have high levels of lead in their blood and paints are key source for it.

Avoid painting your house frequently, especially using lead based paints.









The most fuel-efficient big cars get 16 to 19 Kmpl , while small cars get 25 to 27 Kmpl. Thus 36% lower emission in small cars.

Prefer small cars for environmental and economic benefits.









Burning 10 kg of garden waste may emit 1 kg of carbon monoxide and 1 kg of particulate matter

Do not burn garden waste; Do not pollute environment









Immersing idols made of PoP and painted with chemicals in lakes increases the heavy mental content by tenfold.

Don't use idols made of PoP and painted with chemicals during Vinayahar Chaturthi.









Noise level can go beyond 125 dB (A), during Deepawali while the permitted level in the residential area is 55 dB (A) in daytime and 45 dB (A) at night.

Avoid high noise generating firecrackers & let everybody enjoy Deepawali







#ECOTips

Studies show that PM 2.5 levels ranges between 800 microgram/m3 to 1000 microgram/m3 at certain locations on Bhogi morning which is at least sixteen times more than the prescribed limit

Stop burning tyres and plastics on bogi for real happy Pongal

Out of total E-waste produced only about 35% get recycled and the remaining get disposed along with domestic solid wastes.

Do not dispose E-Waste along with garbage;

Every year 120 billion pieces of single-use plastic cutlery is disposed in India.

Ditch disposable cutlery to save environment.









On an average, an Indian wedding hosting 400-1000 people results in around 3 tonnes of waste

More than 1 million tonnes of textiles are thrown away every year, with most of this coming from household sources.

Donate used clothes today; Donate usable environment to future.

Avoiding elevators and climbing stairs for one floor can save 2.5 Wh of energy thus reducing carbon emission by 2.3 to 2.4 g.

Minimize the use of elevator to minimise your carbon footprint and to improve your fitness.









A Christmas tree of 2m made of plastic has a carbon footprint of 40kg of CO₂, 10 times greater than a real tree.

Avoid artificial Christmas tree for happy Christmas and healthy environment.









Around 80% of waste buried in landfills could have been recycled if classified and processed properly.

Avoid Wishcycling and learn what can and can't be recycled.









Just one mid-sized cruise ship uses 150 tons of fuel daily and has a bigger carbon footprint than 12,000 cars.

Avoid Cruise and Choose sustainable tourism
