The Government also accord financial sanctif for the remaining amount of Rs.13.55 crores (Rupees thirteen crores and fifty five lake only) from the State fund, treating as "New Service Scheme" as detailed in the annexit to this order.

- 9. The Pay and Accounts Officer's/Treasury Officer's concerned are requ to open this new Head of account in their accounts.
