

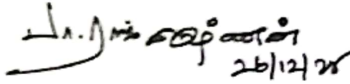

TO CONSIDER THE ISSUE OF CONSENT FOR CTO – AFTER CTE TO THE UNIT 'M/S.KUTHALAM TOWN PANCHAYAT - GASIFIER CREMATORIUM S.F. NO. 611/4, KADALANGUDI VILLAGE, KUTTHALAM TALUK, MAYILADUTHURAI DISTRICT' UNDER THE WATER (PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF POLLUTION) ACT, 1974 AS AMENDED AND UNDER THE AIR (PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF POLLUTION) ACT, 1981 AS AMENDED FOR ITS ACTIVITY.

The District Level Consent Clearance Committee has decided to grant consent for CTO – after CTE to the unit 'M/s. Kuthalam Town Panchayat - Gasifier Crematorium located at S.F. No. 611/4, Kadalangudi Village, Kutthalam Taluk, Mayiladuthurai District' under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 as amended and under the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 as amended for its activity valid up to **31.03.2027** subject to the following conditions:-

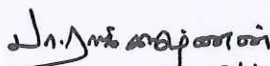
Water Act:

1. The crematorium shall treat and dispose the sewage through septic tank followed by soak pit arrangements.
2. The crematorium shall ensure that no treated/untreated effluent is discharged outside the premises under any circumstances.
3. The crematorium shall dispose the solid waste then and there without any accumulation within the premises.
4. The crematorium shall maintain good housekeeping within the premises.
5. The crematorium shall develop adequate greenbelt for the disposal of treated Trade Effluent.
6. The crematorium has to provide compound wall around its boundaries.
7. The crematorium shall not use "Use and throwaway plastics" such as plastic sheets used for food wrapping, spreading on dining table etc., plastic plates, plastic coated tea cups, plastic tumbler, water pouches and packets, plastic straw, plastic carry bag and plastic flags irrespective of thickness, within the industry premises. Instead unit shall encourage use of eco-friendly alternative such as banana leaf, areca nut palm plate, stainless steel, glass, porcelain plates/cups, cloth bag, jute bag, etc.,

8. In case of revision of consent fee by the Government, the unit shall remit the difference in amount within one month from the date of notification, failing which this order will be withdrawn without any notice and further action will be initiated against the unit as per law.
9. This consent order does not absolve from obtaining necessary permission/ clearance from other Authority or under other Statute as applicable.

Air Act:

1. The crematorium shall operate and maintain the wet scrubber with stack arrangement as Air Pollution Control Measures continuously and efficiently so as to adhere to the Ambient Air Quality / Stack Emission/Ambient Noise Level Standards prescribed by the Board.
2. The crematorium shall ensure that no complaints are received from nearby residents regarding odour nuisance.
3. The crematorium shall adhere to the Ambient Noise level standards prescribed by the Board.
4. The crematorium shall develop adequate greenbelt within the premises.
5. The crematorium has to provide compound wall around its boundaries.
6. In case of revision of consent fee by the Government, the unit shall remit the difference in amount within one month from the date of notification, failing which this order will be withdrawn without any notice and further action will be initiated against the unit as per law.

NO. 612/2B, 613/1, KIDANGAL VILLAGE, THARANGAMPADI TALUK, MAYILADUTHURAI DISTRICT' UNDER THE WATER (PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF POLLUTION) ACT, 1974 AS AMENDED AND UNDER THE AIR (PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF POLLUTION) ACT, 1981 AS AMENDED FOR ITS ACTIVITY.

The District Level Consent Clearance Committee has decided to grant consent for **CTO - DIRECT** to the unit '**M/s. Thiru. B. Jayakumar Ordinary Earth Quarry, located at S.F. No. 612/2B, 613/1, Kidangal Village, Tharangampadi Taluk, Mayiladuthurai District**' under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 as amended and under the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 as amended for its activity valid up to **31.03.2026** subject to the following conditions:-

Water Act:

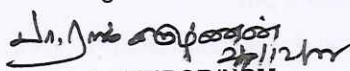
1. The unit shall treat and dispose the sewage generated through septic tank and soak pit arrangements.
2. The unit shall not generate trade effluent at any stage of its manufacturing process.
3. The unit shall restrict the quarrying operations between 7 am and 5 pm.
4. No change in mining technology or scope of working shall be made without prior permission approval of the SEIAA, Tamilnadu.
5. The proponent shall ensure that there shall not be any adverse impacts due to quarrying operation on the nearby human habitations, by way of pollution to the environment.
6. The unit shall furnish the mined quantity of earth duly authorised by the Assistant Director, Department of Geology and Mining, Govt of Tamil Nadu.
7. The unit shall comply the conditions mentioned in the Environmental Clearance obtained from SEIAA vide EC Identification No. EC25C0108TN5100928N dated: 17.11.2025.
8. The unit shall not use "use and throwaway plastics" such as plastic sheets used for food wrapping, spreading on dining table etc., plastic plates, plastic coated teacups, plastic tumbler, water pouches and packets, plastic straw, plastic carry bag and plastic flags irrespective of thickness, within the industry premises. Instead, unit shall encourage use

of ecofriendly alternative such as banana leaf, arecanut palm plate, stainless steel, glass, porcelain plates/cups, cloth bag, jute bag etc.,

9. The unit shall develop green belt all along the boundary of the quarry lease area.
10. The unit's operation shall not attract any public complaints.
11. In case of revision of consent fee by the Government, the unit shall remit the difference in amount within one month from the date of notification. Failing to remit the consent fee, this consent order will be withdrawn without any notice and further action will be initiated against the unit as per law.

Air Act:

1. The unit shall carry out water sprinkling as Air Pollution Control Measures to control the high levels of Particulate Matter such as loading and unloading and all transfer points.
2. The unit shall adhere to Ambient Noise level standards prescribed by the Board.
3. The unit shall restrict the quarrying operations between 7 am and 5 pm.
4. No change in mining technology or scope of working shall be made without prior permission approval of the SEIAA, Tamil Nadu.
5. The unit shall comply the conditions mentioned in the Environmental Clearance obtained from SEIAA vide EC Identification No. EC25C0108TN5100928N dated: 17.11.2025.
6. The unit shall continue to develop green belt all along the boundary of the quarry lease area.
7. The unit's operation shall not attract any public complaints.
8. In case of revision of consent fee by the Government, the unit shall remit the difference in amount within one month from the date of notification. Failing to remit the consent fee, this consent order will be withdrawn without any notice and further action will be initiated against the unit as per law.


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
