TO CONSIDER THE ISSUE OF CONSENT FOR CTO - DIRECT TO THE UNIT M/S. SRIVARIS MARUTHY HOSPITAL, T.S. NO.1045, WARD NO.2, BLOCK NO.15, NAGAPATTINAM TOWN, NAGAPATTINAM TALUK, NAGAPATTINAM DISTRICT UNDER THE WATER (PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF POLLUTION) ACT, 1974 AS AMENDED AND UNDER THE AIR (PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF POLLUTION) ACT, 1981 AS AMENDED FOR ITS ACTIVITY.

The DISTRICT LEVEL CONSENT CLEARANCE COMMITTEE has decided to grant consent for CTO - DIRECT to the unit of M/s. Srivaris Maruthy Hospital located at T.S. No.1045, Ward No.2, Block No.15, Nagapattinam Town, Nagapattinam Taluk, Nagapattinam District under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 as amended and under the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 as amended for its activity valid up to **31.03.2027** subject to the following conditions:-

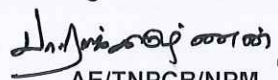
Water Act:

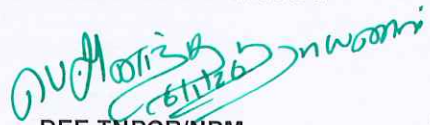
1. The hospital shall treat and dispose the sewage into septic tank and overflow shall be discharged into UGD provided by Nagapattinam Municipality.
2. The hospital shall ensure that the trade effluent generated from Floor and Lab should be properly disinfected with 1 % to 2% Sodium hypochlorite solution before disposal into UGD provided by Nagapattinam Municipality.
3. No treated/untreated trade effluent shall be let outside the premises and shall ensure that no effluent shall reach directly or indirectly any water source or adjacent private/public lands under any circumstances.
4. Any change in the No. of beds and change in management, the hospital shall apply for fresh consent with proper documents.
5. The hospital shall apply and obtain fresh Authorization under Bio Medical Waste Management Rules, 2018 through online immediately after obtaining Consent to Operate-Direct of the Board.
6. The hospital shall segregate the biomedical waste by adopting color coding for the various wastes and shall use the type of containers for disposal of biomedical waste as prescribed in schedule-I of the Biomedical Waste Management Rules, 2018 and shall maintain the label for biomedical waste containers/bags as prescribed in Schedule-IV of the said Rules.

7. Only segregated biomedical wastes from hospital shall be handed over to the CBWTF without accumulating or storing of biomedical waste beyond 48 hrs.
8. The segregated biomedical waste shall be stored in a separate place so as not to cause any infection to the workers or patients in the hospital.
9. The hospital shall comply with the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2018 at all times.
10. The hospital shall not attract any public complaints.
11. The hospital shall not use "use and throwaway plastics" such as plastic sheets used for food wrapping, spreading on dining table etc., plastic plates, plastic coated teacups, plastic tumbler, water pouches and packets, plastic straw, plastic carry bags and plastic flags irrespective of thickness, within the industry premises as per the G.O.(MS)No.84 E&F Department dated 25.06.2018 as amended. Instead unit shall encourage use of eco friendly alternative such as banana leaf, arecanut palm, stainless steel, glass, porcelain plates/cups/cloth bag, jute bag etc.,
12. In case of revision of consent fee by the Government, the unit shall remit the difference in amount within one month from the date of notification. Failing to remit the consent fee, this consent order will be withdrawn without any notice and further action will be initiated against the unit as per law.

Air Act:

1. The hospital shall operate and maintain the acoustic enclosures with stack attached to DG Sets, so as to satisfy the Ambient Air Quality/Emission standards prescribed by the Board.
2. The hospital shall adhere to the Ambient Noise Level standards prescribed by the Board.
3. Any change in the No. of beds and change in management, the hospital shall apply for fresh consent with proper documents.
4. The hospital shall comply with the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2018 at all times.
5. The hospital shall not attract any public complaints.
6. In case of revision of consent fee by the Government, the unit shall remit the difference in amount within one month from the date of notification. Failing to remit the consent fee, this consent order will be withdrawn without any notice and further action will be initiated against the unit as per law.

THE ISSUE OF REJECTION ORDER TO THE UNIT OF M/S. SRI RAM SAWMILL, S.F. NO. 321/6, KEELASATTANATHAPURAM VILLAGE, SEERKAAZHI TALUK, MAYILADUTHURAI DISTRICT UNDER THE WATER (PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF POLLUTION) ACT, 1974 AS AMENDED AND UNDER THE AIR (PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF POLLUTION) ACT, 1981 AS AMENDED FOR ITS ACTIVITY.

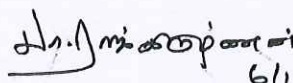
The District Level Consent Clearance Committee has decided to reject the application for CTO - DIRECT to the unit of M/s. Sri Ram Sawmill located at S.F.No.321/6, Keelasattanathapuram Village, Seerkaazhi Taluk, Mayiladuthurai District under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 as amended and under the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 as amended for the following reasons.

The Ambient Noise Level (ANL) Survey conducted on 02.01.2025 revealed that, during operation of the machineries, the noise levels recorded at the main gate and backside of the unit were 75.2 dB and 73.0 dB respectively. Further, noise levels of 65.2 dB near the back door and 74.1 dB before the front door of the complainant, Thiru P. Balachandran's residence, were recorded, indicating that the unit is a significant source of noise affecting the surrounding area.

The Assistant Director (FAC), District Town and Country Planning, in the letter dated: 28.10.2024 stated that the subject survey number falls under a non-planned area. Further, HR&CE vide Proc. No. 37/2025 dated: 22.08.2025 converted the land use from Manai-Punjai to Manai-Commercial. However, during inspection, residential buildings were found on the southern side of the unit.

As per the Board's Ambient Noise Level standards, the permissible limits for residential zones are 55 dB during daytime and 45 dB during night time, while even the commercial zone limits are 65 dB during daytime and 55 dB during night time. The noise levels recorded at the complainant's residence exceed the prescribed ambient noise level standards.

Since, the unit has failed to comply with the ambient noise level standards and attracts frequent noise complaints, due to the operation of the saw mill. Hence, the application filed by M/s. Sri Ram Sawmill located at S.F.No.321/6, Keelasattanathapuram Village, Seerkaazhi Taluk, Mayiladuthurai District is hereby rejected.


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
