DATE OF MEETING: 12.02.2019

To consider the issue of Consent to Operate (Direct) to the unit of M/s. TTK Blue Metals, S.F.No. 946/4, 947/1, Thimmarasanaickanur Bit I Village, Aundipatti Taluk, Theni District under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 as amended and under the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 as amended for its activity.

The DLCCC decided to grant Consent to Operate (Direct) to the unit of M/s. TTK Blue Metals, S.F.No. 946/4, 947/1, Thimmarasanaickanur Bit I Village, Aundipatti Taluk, Theni District under Section 25 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 as amended and under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 as amended for its activity valid up to 31.03.2020 subject to the following conditions:-

Water Act:


1. The unit shall treat the sewage in Septic Tank followed by soak pit.
2. The unit shall treat the trade effluent arising from washing of M.Sand through settling tanks generated from the manufacturing process.
3. The unit shall ensure that treated trade effluent shall be completely recycling to process as reported.
4. The unit shall comply with the conditions stipulated by PWD for M Sand making units in future.
5. The unit shall continue to develop green belt with evergreen high foliage type like neem, tamarind and any other local varieties around the unit premises.
6. The unit shall not to go in for any expansion without prior consent of Board.
7. In case of revision of consent fee by the Government, the unit shall remit the difference in amount within one month from the date of notification. Failing to remit the consent fee, this consent order will be withdrawn without any notice and further action will be initiated against the unit as per law.
8. The issue of this Consent to operate order shall not be construed as revocation of closure direction and restoration of power supply to the unit. The unit shall obtain separate order for the revocation of closure direction and restoration of power supply only from the competent authority.

Air Act:

1. The unit shall operate and maintain the Air pollution control measures efficiently and continuously so as to adhere to the AAQ/Ambient noise level standards prescribed by the board.
2. The unit shall comply with the conditions stipulated by PWD for M Sand making units in future.
3. The unit shall maintain the 20 feet wall of G.I. Sheets and supported on angle structures properly on three sides so that it can withstand strong wind.
4. The unit shall ensure that the drop height of the processed material is kept at a minimum during loading and unloading.
5. The unit shall ensure that openings in the enclosures over Shaft motor driver, conveyor belts etc, are to be covered with rubber flaps (wherever possible) to prevent release of dust.
6. The unit shall maintain the approach road to the unit in good condition to prevent release of dust.

7. The unit shall continue to develop green belt with evergreen high foliage type like neem, tamarind and any other local varieties around the unit premises.
8. The unit shall provide nose masks to all the workers as an occupational safety.
9. The unit shall not to go in for any expansion without prior consent of Board.
10. In case of revision of consent fee by the Government, the unit shall remit the difference in amount within one month from the date of notification. Failing to remit the consent fee, this consent order will be withdrawn without any notice and further action will be initiated against the unit as per law.
11. The issue of this Consent to operate order shall not be construed as revocation of closure direction and restoration of power supply to the unit. The unit shall obtain separate order for the revocation of closure direction and restoration of power supply only from the competent authority.
