
**Implementation of Plastic waste Management (PWM) e.g Collection segregation, disposal (co-processing, road construction etc). (Rules 5&6)**

- In the state of Tamilnadu, there are 12 Corporations, 124 Municipalities and 528 Town Panchayats. In Tamilnadu, plastic waste is collected and segregated to possible extent and utilized for road laying or co- incineration in Cement Plant depending upon the quality of the waste.
- In Chennai, the plastic wastes are collected separately wherever at source. Besides, the sanitary worker separates while collection, the recyclables including plastic waste which will fetch some value and hand over to the local recyclers. The plastics are also collected separately and handed over to the plastic shredding centers. There are totally around 45 nos. of plastics shredding machines of varying capacities at all 15 Zones.
- In Dharmapuri district, segregated plastic waste of 10.90 T was used for road construction; segregated plastic waste of 431 tons from municipalities was used for road construction in Krishnagiri District.
- Plastic waste generated from Madurai Corporation is used for laying of roads and given to recyclers for further processing.
- All local bodies are segregating the plastic waste from municipal solid waste and plastic wastes are used for laying of roads as per GO MS No.211 Dt Aug 23, 2012 in Salem District.
- In Tiruvannamalai District, all four municipalities and 10 town Panchayats are carrying out collection, segregation of plastic waste and are sent for recycling. Pudupalayam and Vettavalam town Panchayats have carried out road laying with plastic waste.
- Segregated plastic wastes of 78 T were used for road construction by the local bodies in Vellore district.
- Awareness programmes are being regularly conducted by the local bodies in the districts of Tirunelveli, Nagercoil, Trichy, Ramanathapuram, Sivagangai, Virudhunagar.
- As per C{CB's instructions through letter dated 16.01.2017, public notices both in English and Tamil were published in leading newspapers (Indian Express and Dinamani) on 16.02.2017 on the features of Plastic Waste Management Rules 2016.

**Annexure B**

**Complete ban on usages of Plastic carrybags etc. In State/UT or partial ban at historical places, pilgrimage places, beaches etc.**

- Plastic carrybags are partially and completely banned by some of the local bodies in the State of Tamil Nadu.
- The use of plastic carrybags is banned in 31 local bodies of Coimbatore District. Kodaikanal and Palani municipalities have banned the usage of plastic carry bags. The resolutions have been already passed by the local bodies and notification has been issued in District Gazette.
- Resolutions were passed by the local bodies to prohibit the usage of carry bag <50 microns in the districts of Krishnagiri, Tiruvannamalai, Tiruppur, Vaniyambadi and Vellore.
- Madurai Corporation has banned the usage of carry bags less than 50 microns around 1 Km radius from Meenakshi Amman temple with effect from 01.01.2017 and also the usage of plastic carrybags has been banned in the Mamallapuram Shore temple site.
- The usage of plastic is completely banned in all the 5 Municipalities and 19 Town Panchayats in Namakkal District.
- The municipalities and town panchayats have passed a resolution to ban the usage of banned plastic products and regular meeting is being conducted under the Chairmanship of District Collector, Pudukottai every month to monitor the issues in the Pudukkottai District.
- Kutchanur & Highways Town Panchayat of Theni district have completely banned the usage of plastic carrybags.
- There are 4 Municipalities and 11 Town Panchayats in Nilgiris District. The usage of plastic carry bags is banned in Nilgiris District.
