

**Procedure for Submission of Application for Registration of Producers by CPCB under Rule 4 of the Batteries Waste Management Rules, 2022**

**Background:**

Ministry of Environment Forest & Climate Change has notified the Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022 (BWM Rules, 2022) on 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2022 in suppression of Battery (Management & Handling) Rules, 2001. Copy of BWM Rules, 2022 is given at Annexure I.

As per Rule 3 (u) of BWM Rules, 2022, Producer means an entity who engages in:

- Manufacture and sale of batteries including refurbished batteries, including in equipment, under its own brand; or
- Sale of batteries including refurbished batteries, including in equipment, under its own brand produced by other manufacturers or suppliers; or
- Import of batteries as well as equipment containing batteries.

As per Rule 3 (s) of BWM Rules, 2022, manufacturer means a person or an entity or a company as defined in the Companies Act, 2013 (18 of 2013) or a factory as in the Factories Act, 1948 (63 of 1948) which has facilities for manufacturing of Battery and / or its components.

As per Rule 4 of BWM Rules, 2022, every Producer and person or an entity involved in manufacturing of battery shall have to register with CPCB through online centralised portal for which the application is required to be submitted in Form 1 (A) to CPCB. Copy of Form 1 (A) is given at Annexure II.

**Details of submission of Application for registration to CPCB:**

Online Centralized Portal of CPCB is under development and till such time offline mode is adopted in order to receive applications for registration. Procedure for submission of application by the producer/manufacturer in offline mode to CPCB is given below:

1. Producer/Manufacturer has to apply for grant of registration to CPCB by submitting duly filled Form 1 (A) through email at [batteries.cpcb@gov.in](mailto:batteries.cpcb@gov.in) and the hardcopy of application to be submitted to Member Secretary, Central Pollution Control Board at following address:

2. The application shall be submitted from company's email ID only.
3. Producer/Manufacturer shall also submit the following documents along with the application form:
  - a. Self-attested copy of GST Certificate
  - b. TIN number
  - c. CIN number
  - d. Aadhar Card of authorised person
  - e. Pan Card of company

Registration will be granted initially for a period of six months, which will be renewed through online portal once it gets operational. Meanwhile, the collection of application fees will be deferred and will be realized at the time of registration through the online centralized portal.
