JOINT COMMITTEE REPORT IN THE MATTER OF ORIGINAL APPLICATION NO. 51/2015 FILED BY THIRU.V. MANICKAM AS PER THE DIRECTION OF HON'BLE NATIONAL GREEN TRIBUNAL ORDER DATED 28/01/2021 AND 27/07/2021.

1. Back Ground

The Hon'ble NGT in its order dated 28/01/2021 directed as follows.

- "... 10. Instead of directing the Salem Municipal Corporation to conduct the environmental study, the regulator themselves can undertake that exercise to ascertain as to whether there is any environmental damage caused and if so, who are all responsible for the same to recover the environmental compensation from them, and also to provide necessary recommendation for restoration of the damage caused to the environment etc., and they can use the fund which has been collected by them as environmental compensation initially for this purpose and recover the cost of conducting the study from those units or those Institutions who were responsible for the pollution as contributors, so that the expenses incurred initially can be recouped in that way. They will have to carry out the exercise within a period of 3 months and submit a detailed report to this Tribunal.
- 11. They are also directed to conduct further inspection of these units and submit a detailed report as to whether the directions given by them were properly complied with and whether there is any improvement in the pollution control mechanism and whether the water quality of the lake has improved on account of the mechanism that has been subsequently provided as per the directions of the Pollution Control Board. If there is any gap then, they are also directed to submit their recommendations to fill up the gap in this regard
- 12. Further, we feel that it is better to direct the joint committeethat has been appointed by this Tribunal to consider these issuesas has been directed to be conducted by the PollutionControlBoard as Pollution Control Board is also one of the members of the committee.
- 13. The Central Pollution Control Board is a member of the jointcommittee that has been appointed as per order dated04.02.2019. So the Central Pollution Control Board can considerthese aspects and submit a further report to this Tribunal asdirected as the joint committee member.
- 14. The Joint Committee, the Pollution Control Board, CPCB as wellas the Salem Municipal Corporation are directed to submit therespective reports as directed by this Tribunal on or before05.04.2021, by e-filing in the form of searchable PDF/OCRSupport PDF and not in the form of Image PDF along withnecessary hard copies to be produced as per rules."

Further, the Hon'ble NGT in its order dated 27/07/2021 directed as follows;

"... 14. The Joint Committee is also directed to inspect the area again and submit the progress report and also improvement in the water quality and suggest further remedial measures including short-term measures to achieve the water quality in Thirumanimutharu River by avoiding discharge of untreated sewage till underground sewage system is completed and fully utilised by the Corporation..."

The joint committee is directed to submit the report to the Hon'ble Tribunal on or before 18.11.2021 by e-filing.

2. Details of Inspection Carried out in Compliance to Hon'ble NGT order dt. 28.01.2021

2.1 Status of Industries inspection

In view of the above order, the joint committee inspected the River Thirumanimutharu area, lakes, textile processing units and sago industries from 09/03/2021 to 11/03/2021 by the following officials

The committee had inspected all the units located in the Thirumanimutharu area and observed that out of 92 units, 41 units were under operation and 6 (4 No's of dyeing units and 2 No's of Sago units) of them were discharging effluent into the River Thirumanimutharu and were violating norms. Hence, Closure and Power supply disconnection directions were issued by the TNPCB to the said 6 No's of units. 35 units were already under closure as per the direction issued by the TNPC Board and 16 units were not in operation. The details of the units inspected and their present status is enclosed as **Annexure-1**. The action taken against the defaulting industries are given in the below table.

2.2 Status of the recovery of the environmental compensation and litigations pending:

In compliance to the Hon'ble NGT order dt. 04.02.2019 & 10.04.2019, joint committee carried out inspection in the Month of February 2019 and environmental compensation were arrived to the defaulting units and report submitted to Hon'ble Tribunal in the month of August 2019. The details of compensation imposed, remittance and the balance to be collected from the industries are tabulated below:

11 number of textile dyeing units have filed an appeal against the environmental compensation imposed against those units filed before the Hon'ble Appellate Authority. Counter affidavits are being prepared by the Board to vacate the stay issued by the Appellate Authority regarding Environmental Compensation. The detail of the environmental compensation and their present status is tabulated in **Annexure-1**.

2.3 Details of unauthorized dyeing units:

TNPCB is periodically identifying the unauthorized dyeing units in that area and taking action against those units. The following 14 numbers of unauthorized dyeing units were identified and the power supply to these units was disconnected by the District Coordination Committee.

2.4 Status of the Seelvari lake:

The Seelvari lake was inspected & it was observed that the lake has been partially developed into residential layout and plots have been developed and sold by the Tamil Nadu Housing Board. The sewage from the TNHB Colony and the nearby residence are let out in part of the Seelvari Lake that is undeveloped. During the inspection it was observed that the untreated sewage is being disposed to the lake. The present physical scenario of the lake seems to be a drain. The flow path of the drain system is grown with dense bushes. At time of sampling, the local resident informed that the lake is encroached by TNHB for residential layout. Water sample from the lake was collected and analysed, the ROA is tabulated below

3. Details of Compliance w.r.t Hon'ble NGT order dt. 27.07.2021

3.1 Status of Sewage Treatment Plants:

The Salem Corporation has obtained stay order by Writ Petition No. 5879/2019 from the High Court of Judicature at Madras to pay interim compensation of Rs. 25 lakhs and furnishing performance guarantee of Rs. 50 lakhs.

Further based on the status report filed by the Salem City Municipal Corporation, the Hon'ble NGT in its order dated 09.09.2020 has directed to complete the works as stated in its report and directed the pollution control Board to monitor the same. In this regard the following are submitted:

b) Monitoring of Sewage Treatment Plants:

Samples are being collected from the 3 Nos of STPs namely M/s. Vellakuttai STP, M/s. Anaimedu STP and M/s. Mankuttai STP. The Consolidated ROA of the treated sewage collected from the STP's from the month of December 2020 to May 2021 are enclosed as **Annexure-2**. The analysis report reveals that the STP's are not meeting the standard in most of the instance except Mankuttai STP meets in Month of Dec 2021 & January 2021 and Anaimedu STP meets in month of April & May 2021.

During the inspection, the following were observed;

- In the Anaimedu STP so for no sludge is generated, which indicates that no proper treatment is being carried out.
- Mankuttai STP was not in operation on the day of inspection, it is observed that the inlet chamber is deposited with sludge and workers are deployed to remove the deposited sludge, which indicates that periodic improper operation of STP.
- In Vellakuttai STP, sewage flowing through the drain was found diverted partially to STP collection tank for treatment. Alage growth was found in the treatment system and

in this STP also so for no sludge is generated, which indicated the improper operation of STP

• No proper disinfection of treated sewage is observed in all three STPs.


3.2 Monitoring of the River Thirumanimutharu:

The Hon'ble NGT in its order Dated 10.04.2019 has directed the TNPCB to monitor the River Quality Parameters. In this regard it is submitted to inform that monthly samples were collected from the River Thirumanimutharu at Anaimedu Checkdam (upstream side) and at Uthamasolapuram (downstream side) of the River. The consolidated ROA of the samples collected were submitted below;

BOD Details

a) BOD (mg/L): In the upstream side the parameter varies from <2mg/L to 36mg/L and the mean value is 14 mg/L. In the downstream side the parameter varies from 6mg/L to 36mg/L and the mean value is 24 mg/L. Based on the data a line chart was plotted and the trend lines shows that at the downstream of the River the BOD is in increasing trend. The untreated sewage is the main reason for BOD contribution.</p>



b) TDS (mg/L): In the upstream side the parameter varies from 976 mg/L to 2084 mg/L and the mean value is 1534 mg/L. In the downstream side the parameter varies from 844 mg/L to 1692 mg/L and the mean value is 1450 mg/L. Based on the data a line chart was plotted and the trend lines shows that at downstream of the River the TDS level is in increasing



c) Total Coliforms (MPN/100 ml): In the upstream side the parameter varies from 390 mg/L to 1300 mg/L and the mean value is 882 mg/L. In the downstream side the parameter varies from 460 mg/L to 1500 mg/L and the mean value is 1087 mg/L. Based on the data a line chart was plotted and the trend lines shows that at downstream of the River the Total Coliform level is in decreasing trend. The Salem Corporation shall operate the STPs in full-fledged manner to decrease the value further.

4. Conclusions/ Suggestions:

4.1 W.r.t. Hon'ble NGT order dated 28.01.2021

Para 10. Instead of directing the Salem Municipal Corporation to conduct the environmental study, the regulator themselves can undertake that exercise to ascertain as to whether there is any environmental damage caused and if so, who are all responsible for the same to recover the environmental compensation from them, and also to provide necessary recommendation for restoration of the damage caused to the environment etc., and they can use the fund which has been collected by them as environmental compensation initially for this purpose and recover the cost of conducting the study from those units or those Institutions who were responsible for the pollution as contributors, so that the expenses incurred initially can be recouped in that way. They will have to carry out the exercise within a period of 3 months and submit a detailed report to this Tribunal.

Based on the study, it is found that the Seelvari lake is got polluted due to the discharge of untreated sewage and also encroachment of the lake was observed. The lake has been partially developed into residential layout and plots have been developed and sold by the Tamil Nadu Housing Board.

In compliance to the Hon'ble NGT order dt. 04.02.2019& 10.04.2019, joint committee calculated the environmental compensation for discharge of untreated sewage and report submitted to Hon'ble Tribunal in the month of August 2019. The environmental compensation calculated Rs. 3430.416 Lakhs.

Hon'ble NGT in its order dt 04.02.2019 imposed interim compensation of Rs. 25 lakhs and furnishing performance guarantee of Rs. 50 lakhs. Salem corporation has obtained stay order by Writ Petition No. 5879/2019 from the High Court of Judicature at Madras in this regard. So, the environmental compensation calculated by the committee is also not reemitted by Salem Corporation.

Suggestion for Restoration of Lake:

Salem Corporation shall submit an Action Plan for restoration of the Lake within a month including the following suggestions;

Short Term:

Possibilities shall be explored for Diversion of untreated sewage discharged into the lake
to STP through pipeline or by providing collection sump & transporting through tankers
to STP for treatment or providing in-situ treatment system within six month.

Long Term:

- Removal of encroachment.
- Removal of hyacinths, weeds, floating materials and desilting, bunding etc.
- To provide wall with fencing arrangements and foreshore bund along the foreshore boundary of Lake to curtail the encroachments and illegal dumping of solid waste

These long term activities shall be completed within a year for which the Salem coloration shall prepare an activity based pert chart to adhere the timeline.

Para 11. They are also directed to conduct further inspection of these units and submit a detailed report as to whether the directions given by them were properly complied with and whether there is any improvement in the pollution control mechanism and whether the water quality of the lake has improved on account of the mechanism that has been subsequently provided as per the directions of the Pollution Control Board. If there is any gap then, they are also directed to submit their recommendations to fill up the gap in this regard

Joint Committee inspected 92 industries in that area to assess the status of pollution control mechanism adopted. The details of the units inspected and their present status is enclosed as

Annexure-1. In which six industries found violating the norms, so TNPCB has initiated the action and issued closure direction and power supply disconnection.

No industries are situated around this Lake& no industrial discharge observed. As mentioned in the earlier para, Lake got polluted due to discharge of the untreated sewage and no fresh water flow was observed in the lake.

4.2W.r.t. Hon'ble NGT order dated 27.07.2021.

Para 14. The Joint Committee is also directed to inspect the area again and submit the progress report and also improvement in the water quality and suggest further remedial measures including short-term measures to achieve the water quality in Thirumanimutharu River by avoiding discharge of untreated sewage till underground sewage system is completed and fully utilized by the Corporation

The improvement in the water quality is not observed due to discharge of untreated sewage into the River.

Salem Corporation has installed 98 MLD capacity of treatment system out of which 22.5 MLD is only treated and remaining 75.5 MLD is discharged as untreated into the river.

As per the earlier joint committee report, sewage treated by Salem Corporation as on 21.05.2019 is 2 MLD and presently increased the treatment quantity to 22.5 MLD as on October 2021. The progress made by the Salem Corporation for treating the sewage even after establishment of STP is very slow.

Untreated sewage is flowing through & nearby drains from the established STPs, so it is possible to divert untreated sewage into the STPs for further treatment. The same is suggested in the joint committee report submitted in the month of April 2019, but no action has been taken by the Salem Corporation to run the STP in full capacities.

The joint committee observed that the operation of the STP is not effective & efficient to meet the discharge standards.

Suggestions to be implemented by Salem Corporation:

- Diverting of untreated sewage flowing through & nearby drains to the STP for the treatment within a month
- Possibilities shall be explored for Diversion of untreated sewage discharged into the lake
 to STP through pipeline or by providing collection sump & transporting through tankers
 to STP for treatment or providing in-situ treatment system within six months.
- The Salem Corporation shall commence the four Nos. of STP's in full pledged manner.
 All the house hold connections should be connected with UGSS and it should stop the untreated sewage disposal into the Thirumanimutharu before April 2022.

 The Salem Corporation shall operate and maintain the four STPs efficiently so as to the treated sewage will achieve prescribed standard of the Board since some of the parameters are not achieving the prescribed standard of the Board.

Suggestions to be implemented by industries:

There are 89 small scale textile processing units are located in Salem. All the units have provided ETP, RO and Reject Management system. Some of the units have provided Solar Evaporation Pan. During rainy time, overflow is taking place. Hence, the units have been requested by TNPCB to provide agitated thin film dryer instead of solar evaporation pan for above 100 KLD capacity. Closure direction is being issued by TNPCB if discharge found. In addition, in Salem dyers Association has been requested to form CETP at the earliest to sort out this issue.

Suggestions to identify illegal dyers:

It is observed that most of illegal dyeing is being carried out in the residential houses itself. Time to time TNPCB is identifying the illegal dyers and sealing it through District Coordination Committee.

TANGEDCO is issuing commercial power supply to these residential houses. In order to avoid illegal dyeing units, TANGEDCO shall verify the commercial activity before giving the commercial power supply. Moreover, TANGEDCO is taking monthly/bimonthly readings of the power consumption house to house, during this time, the activities may be verified based on the power consumption. If any, illegal dyeing activities is noticed the same shall be reported to District Coordination Committee as well as TNPCB for further action.

In this regard, necessary directions to TANGEDCO shall be given by the Board and the District Collector, Salem.
