Sealed Quotations are Invited for the service and maintenance of two Reverse Vending Machines installed in the Hon'ble High Court of Madras

The TNPCB has installed two Reverse Vending Machines (PET bottle crusher machine) in the Hon'ble High Court of Madras premises to maintain the campus Single Use Plastic (SUP) Free and ensure the proper collection of PET bottles. To maintain the two Reverse Vending Machines installed in the Hon'ble High Court premises in full working condition, it requires periodic servicing and maintenance.

In this regard, Firms which are in the Service and Maintenance of Reverse Vending Machines, are requested to offer quotations through sealed envelope for the service and maintenance of two Reverse Vending Machines for one year, as per the following terms and conditions, with the least possible quote to the TNPCB Corporate Office, No.76, Mount Salai, Guindy, Chennai – 600032, on or before **16.08.2024** at **11.00 AM**.

Terms and Conditions:

- a) The period of contract is for One year from the date of execution of MoU/Agreement.
- b) Upon the notification of breakdown or failure in the vending machine, the company shall send Technician/Service personnel as soon as it may reasonably be possible during the company's normal working hours, and the technician shall carry out necessary repairs in order to restore the vending machine to satisfactory working condition.
- c) In case of replacement of any damaged worn or faulty parts, the cost of the replaced or repaired parts will be borne by TNPCB.

d) Reverse Vending Machine service shall be done every month with lubrication and by cleaning the machine, controller, bearing, guides and if required make minor adjustments to ensure smooth and safe operation of the Reverse Vending Machine.

e) Be entitled to depute authorized service personnel to attend all call back during normal working hours, free of charges.

f) Apart from the lubrication oil and grease. The Gear oil, Rope lubrication oil replenish/refill is the additional cost in this contract.

g) During the period of servicing, the Reverse Vending Machine operator should be present until the servicing work is completed.

h) In case of termination/cancellation of contract, refund of payment if already received, will be made after deducting the charges proportionately towards service already rendered.
